



Andrew's pool in Stirling. Perth.

This pool was in a poor state having been coated beforehand with Chlorinated Rubber pool paint. A coating that while very economical does not last for any length of time.

Perth Pool Paint (Robert Jackson and his team) were engaged to repair the surface and then apply a new longer lasting coating system. They chose Epotec, the proven pool coating. Robert used a high pressure water blaster to remove the existing chlorinated rubber paint. He then found many areas of drummy render which were dug out and repaired, prior to re coating. Some were 2.5 meters across and up to 25 mm deep.

There after the pool was sealed with Epotec WB (Water Based) Sealer after which coated with 2 coats of high build Epotec in colour Tasman. The end result speaks for itself. A great improvement and a long lasting asset.
